



NHF Quarterly Budget and Investment Reports

Lisa McCargar, Chief Financial Officer, presented the Quarterly NHF Investment Report, Budget Report, and Liquidity Report for period ending December 31, 2018.

NHF 2019 Investment Policy

Lisa McCargar reviewed the NHF 2019 Investment Policy with the Board of Directors. Ms. McCargar pointed out that the only revisions are applicable date changes.

Recognition of the 2019 NHF Board of Directors and Appointment of Corporate Officers

Greg Norton, President, reviewed the following NHF Bylaws with the NHF Board:

NHF Bylaws, Section 4. (e) states that the Directors of the corporation shall be the current Chair, Vice Chair and President (or his or her designee) of RCRC and the current Chair and Vice Chair of Golden State Finance Authority (GSFA). Bylaws, Section 6. (a) further states that the Chair shall be the current Chair of GSFA and the Vice Chair shall be the current Vice Chair of GSFA.

As RCRC President, Mr. Norton announced that he has designated Supervisor Les Baugh, Shasta County, to serve as the RCRC President designee for 2019. Supervisor Baugh will occupy the RCRC President's seat as a Director of the NHF Board.

Mr. Norton reviewed the NHF Bylaws with the Board in regard to the 2019 Corporate Officers.

The Bylaws (Section 6. (b)) state the following: The President shall be the President of RCRC, the Chief Financial Officer shall be the Chief Financial Officer of RCRC and Secretary shall be the Secretary of RCRC. 

NHF Program Investment - ACTION

Summary

Staff continues to pursue efforts to enhance the existing down payment assistance (DPA) program. As discussed prior, the market currently presents limitations to accessing funds for DPA, especially at certain levels of pricing.

It is requested that NHF commit up to \$10MM of existing resources to provide DPA in the form of second mortgage loans in conjunction with the existing DPA program/s. The second mortgages will be structured as 0% rate, repayable at sale or refinance of the property, or forgiven after a certain period.

NHF would be investing resources into program/s that originally generated these resources. Reinvestment of these resources is in line with NHF's mission and public purpose. Further, with origination, the pricing structure and controls are expected to generate resources sufficient to provide a reasonable return on investment and to protect the investment while meeting NHF's mission to assist homebuyers.

Recommendation

It is recommended the NHF Board of Directors approve a commitment of up to \$10MM of existing resources to provide DPA in the form of second mortgage loans in conjunction with the existing DPA program/s.
